TSA Board of Directors meets quarterly in face-to-face meetings located in various areas of the state. Board meetings are typically held on Fridays beginning at 9:00am and ending around 3:00pm. Each board member is expected to serve on at least one committee. Committees generally hold meeting via conference call, but occasionally meet face-to-face depending on the nature of the meeting. All candidates must be willing to travel at their own expense to attend meetings. TSA does not reimburse expenses to board members, it is a voluntary position. Board members are expected to attend the annual conference at their own expense, where 2 meetings are held.

Candidate's member organization must be in good standing with the association to be considered. TSA bylaws only allow for one representative per member organization to serve on the board at a time.
